This year at **NP's VBS**, kids (K-6th grade) will focus their telescopes on the marvels painted in the night sky by our amazing God! And when they, they'll discover the wonder among all wonders: that the God who created everything there is—the knowable and the unknowable, the visible and the invisible—wants a personal relationship with them! When they come to our clubhouse, we'll show them the God who is over the moon in love with them.

Here's what we'll explore throughout the week:

Monday - The Relationship Began (Genesis 1:1-2,26-31; John 1:1,14): The God who created everything wants a relationship with us.

Tuesday - The Relationship Broken (Genesis 3): Sin messed everything up, but God is still in control.

Wednesday - The Restoration Promised (Isaiah 7:14; Matthew 1:18-24; Luke 2:22-38): God sent His Son, Jesus, to be the Savior of the world.

Thursday - The Relationship Restored (Mark 15:22-16:7, 26:17-30): God had a special plan for Jesus to live a perfect life in our place, to die for our sins, and to take us with him to heaven.

Friday - The Relationship Continues (John 21:1-19; Acts 1:4,8): Even though I mess up while I'm still here on earth, God still loves me, will never leave me, and will take me to heaven when I die.

4th – Green

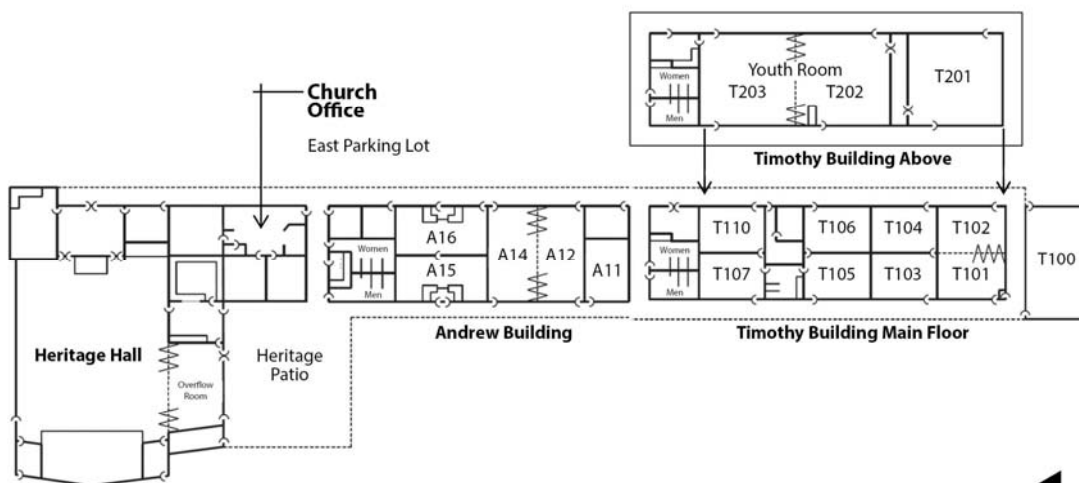
5th – Red
