Prayer Outcomes

Easter is coming. It was during this Season of Redemption that Jesus Christ purchased the privilege of coming to Him in prayer with His blood. Prayer is a significant act—a God-given opportunity to take part in the great work He is accomplishing in the world. On the night before He died, Jesus told us His purpose for giving us access to The Father.

- Jesus wants our prayer to produce much fruit in our lives and ministries. *You did not choose Me, but I chose you, and appointed you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain, so that whatever you ask of the Father in My name He may give it to you. –John 15:16*
- In prayer, Christ desires to accomplish through us works greater than those He performed on earth. *He who believes in me, the works that I do, he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to the Father. Whatever you ask in My name, that will I do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If you ask Me anything in My name, I will do it. –John 14:11-14*
- Through prayer, God reveals Himself to us, giving insight into His nature and ways. *An hour is coming when I will no longer speak to you in figurative language, but will tell you plainly of the Father. In that day you will ask in My name,*

Christ to use you to reveal Himself to your friends and colleagues. Ask for opportunities and boldness for sharing.	10) Read: Exodus 22 Pray for ... Christ to be exalted in Home Gardens. May many people come to know and worship Him in that area of our city.	11) Read: Exodus 23 Pray for ... God to restore marriage in our land and lead us to reject laws and practices that undermine marriage and the family.	12) Read: Exodus 24 Pray for ... God to raise up a new generation of missionaries to proclaim Jesus as Savior & Lord to the ends of the earth, so everyone will know He died on the cross for all sin.	13) Read: Exodus 25 Give thanks! Jesus Christ suffered death for us, so we can have life in Him. His time in the grave freed us from the penalty of death for our sins.

May they see the love of Christ in you and hear of His love from you.	24) Read: Exodus 36 Pray for ... God to reveal His love to the families of our community, especially those who are broken and dysfunctional (1 Corinthians 12:6-29).	25) Read: Exodus 37 Pray for ... God to give His people faith & unity in prayer, <i>So that with one mind and one voice [we] may glorify the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ.</i> Pray for revival & renewal.	26) Read: Exodus 38 Pray for ... Protection for those undergoing persecution for their faith. Pray for strength to remain faithful. Pray for Christ-like love for their persecutors.	27) Read: Exodus 39 Thank God ... For His creation and provision, and for bringing you the good news of salvation. God has loved you with an everlasting love.
28) Read: Exodus 40 Pray for ... Andria Brucks, Ministry Associate, Finance: Ask God to use the management of His money to enhance the work of Christ & magnify His name.	29) Read: Leviticus 1 Pray for ... Your spouse and children or your closest friends: Seek the Holy Spirit's filling for Christ-like character and bold witness.	30) Read: Leviticus 2 Pray for ... Leaders, coworkers and friends at work.
