
Love one another ...


Prayer for ...

The Lord's Prayer Guide

Our Lord did not leave us in ignorance about how to pray or what to pray about. What we usually call "the Lord's Prayer" is really our prayer. Jesus gave it to us to shape the way we pray and to influence the things we seek from God. Give Matthew 6:9-13 a good look.

- *Pray, then, in this way:* The Lord's Prayer is not so much for recitation as it is for imitation. It is a guide for how to pray.
- Hallowed be Your name: Our priority in prayer—in life—is the glory of God.
- Your kingdom come: The purpose of our prayer is to serve God's kingdom.
- Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven: Submission to God's will guides our prayers and enables us understand the way He answers them.
- Give us this day our daily bread: The essence of prayer is our declaration of dependence on God for our every need.
- Forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors: As we receive forgiveness from God, we must extend forgiveness to others. Grace is the currency of God's kingdom.
- Lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil: God's spiritual protection is our most significant need.
- Yours is the Kingdom and the power and the glory forever: The cause we serve is God's. The power we need is God's. He gets all the glory, and we have the eternal joy of knowing Him.

The key to answered prayer is letting God be the author of our prayers. When we allow Him to determine our desires, He is more than willing to grant our requests.

Ask God to give us a vision for His kingdom, so we take part in His plan to win people from every nation, kindred, and tribe to Jesus Christ.	26) Read: 1 st John 3 Prayfor our Mission. Ask God to direct your heart to specific individuals to reach out to with concrete examples of His love and clear expressions of the Gospel.
27) Read: 1st John 4 Pray for Andria Brucks, Ministry Associate, Finance. Ask God for special grace in working with the church's finances, so we honor Him & serve His kingdom with what He provides.	28) Read: 1 st John 5 Pray for Ask God to build your home.
