## Weekly Prayer Focus

April 12, 2020

### He Lives!

*And as Jesus was going up to Jerusalem, he took the twelve disciples aside, and on the way he said to them, "See, we are going up to Jerusalem. And the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and scribes, and they will condemn him to death and deliver him over to the Gentiles to be mocked and flogged and crucified, and he will be raised on the third day." –Matthew 20:17-19*

How does the saying go? "Life is what happens while we're busy making other plans." One day long ago, the Creator of heaven and earth, slipped into a stable unnoticed, while the world looked the other way. Clearly the most momentous things happen when we're preoccupied with other things. That's why Christ tells us repeatedly to be watchful (Matthew 24:42; Mark 14:34; Luke 12:37; 21:36).

This warning applies especially to those who are called of God. No Christian just happened to decide to believe on Jesus as Savior. *No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draws him* (John 6:44). Jesus hand picked His disciples to proclaim the good news of His kingdom, but as He revealed God's plan of redemption to them weeks ahead of time, they were oblivious. They were focused on other things.

Toward the end of His ministry, Jesus told His disciple what would happen when they got to Jerusalem.

- He would be betrayed: *the Son of Man will be delivered over to the chief priests and scribes* (Matthew 20:18).
- The leaders of His own people would condemn Him to death: *and they will condemn him to death and deliver him over to the Gentiles* (20:19a).
- The Romans would abuse and crucify Him: *to be mocked and flogged and crucified* (20:19b).
- He would rise from the grave: *and he will be raised on the third day* (20:19c).

Luke described the disciples' reaction. *And they understood none of these things and this saying was hidden from them, and they did not grasp what was said* (Luke 18:34, literal translation). Matthew's account gives a glimpse of what the disciples were really focused on. *Then the mother of the sons of Zebedee came up to him with her sons, and ... said to him, "Say that these two sons of mine are to sit, one at your right hand and one at your left, in your kingdom"* (Matthew 20:20 and 21b). They had their own plans.

Nothing distracts us from hearing what God has to say as much as our own personal agenda! Jesus told his disciples exactly how His plan of redemption would unfold, and they still missed it. Even after hearing the news of Jesus' resurrection, two of His disciples complained in dismay, *But we had hoped that he was the one to redeem Israel* (Luke 24:21). They were so caught up in their own expectations they couldn't see what was happening. Amazing!

But Christ cut through the fog of their self-centered expectations and misdirected intentions. After appearing to His followers for forty days, ascending into heaven, and sending His Holy Spirit into His people, the light dawned. We live today in the hope of their eyewitness testimony.

Jesus went to Jerusalem, knowing He would be rejected. Then He carried His cross, expecting to be crucified. He allowed Himself to be put to death, knowing He would rise again. His disciples heard Him predict it, then they watched Him do it. They weren't ready for it. They weren't expecting it, but it happened, and it changed their lives—and ours—literally forever.

After years of security, prosperity, and freedom, we have a world of plans, distractions, and preoccupations. Lord, help us not to miss what you're doing! Strengthen our faith. Free us to proclaim new life in Christ. Turn our focus from what we want and expect. Open our eyes to what you're doing, so we can serve you faithfully.

## Prayer for the Week

Like Martha was, we are *anxious and troubled about many things* (Luke 10:41). How will I keep my job? What's going to happen to my investments? Will I—or someone I love—get the virus? Do our leaders know how to handle this situation?

**Wednesday (Neighborhood and Community):** Pray for the neighbors to your left and right. Ask God to use you in their lives.

**Thursday (Our Nation):** Pray that Jesus, the Lamb of God, will be exalted and embraced in our land, so we worship Him as He is revealed in Scripture, not as we imagine Him to be.

**Friday (The World):** Pray for spiritual transformation and physical healing for those suffering in from corona virus, which is threatening people in every nation.

**Saturday (Praise and Rejoicing):** *Rejoice!* The tomb is empty. Jesus Christ is alive, and by God's grace, your name is written in the book of life.
