
# CONGREGATIONAL RESPONSE

Will you, the members of Northpoint Evangelical Free Church, commit yourselves to the progress and joy of their faith? Will you encourage them when they are fainthearted?





Total Giving by Month





(YTD through March 2021 - Same Period vs Same Period)


#### **General Fund - Giving**

(YTD through March 2021- Same Period vs Same Period)




#### **General Fund - Expenses**
