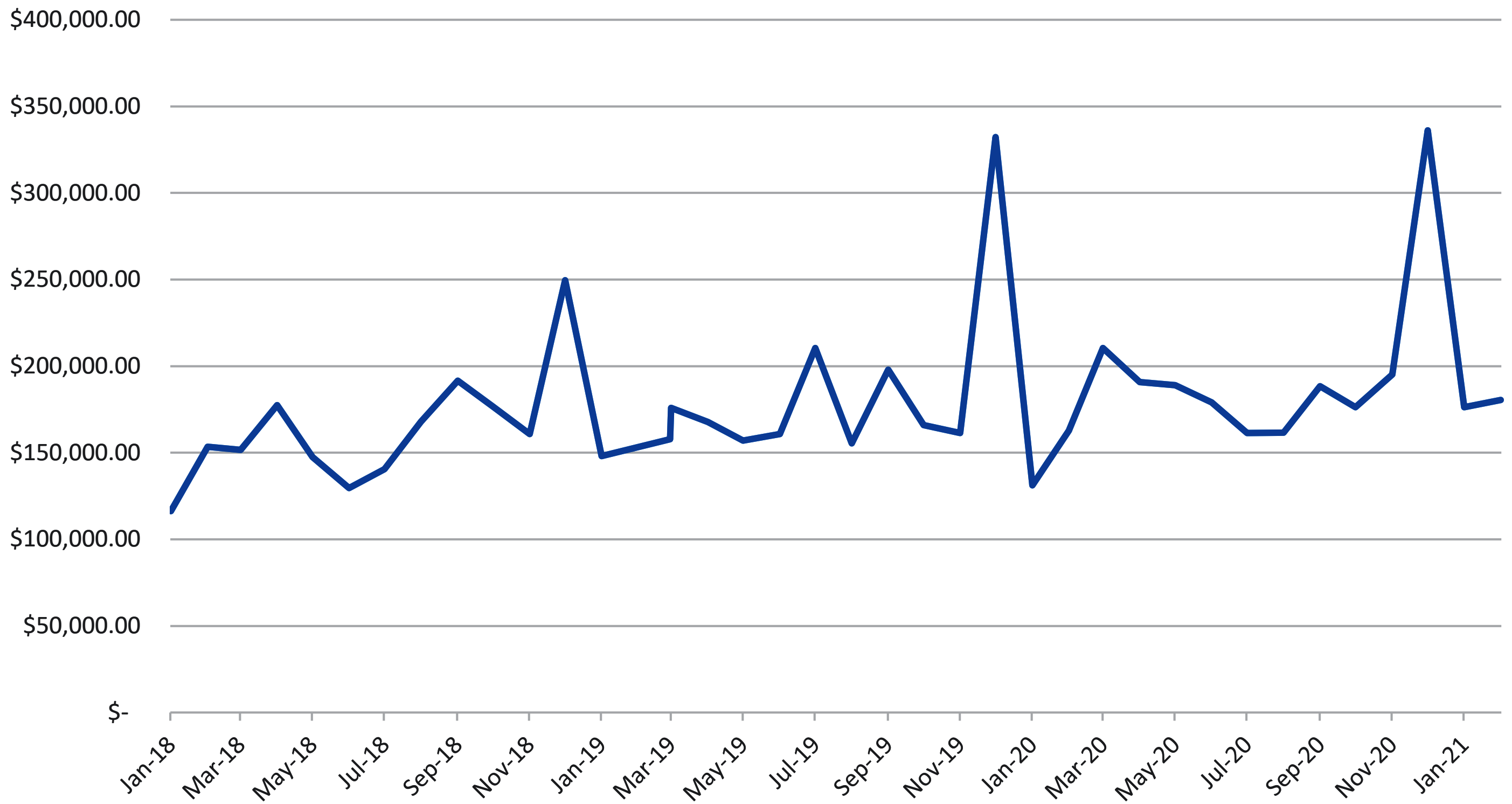

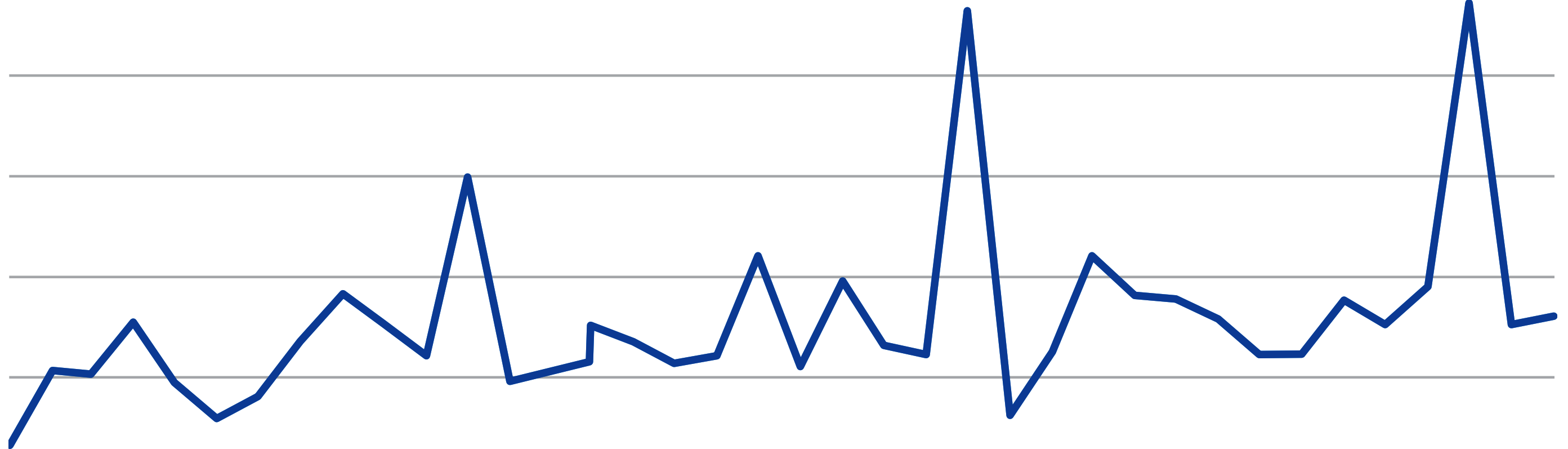


# GIVING TRENDS @ NORTHPOINT 2018 - 2021

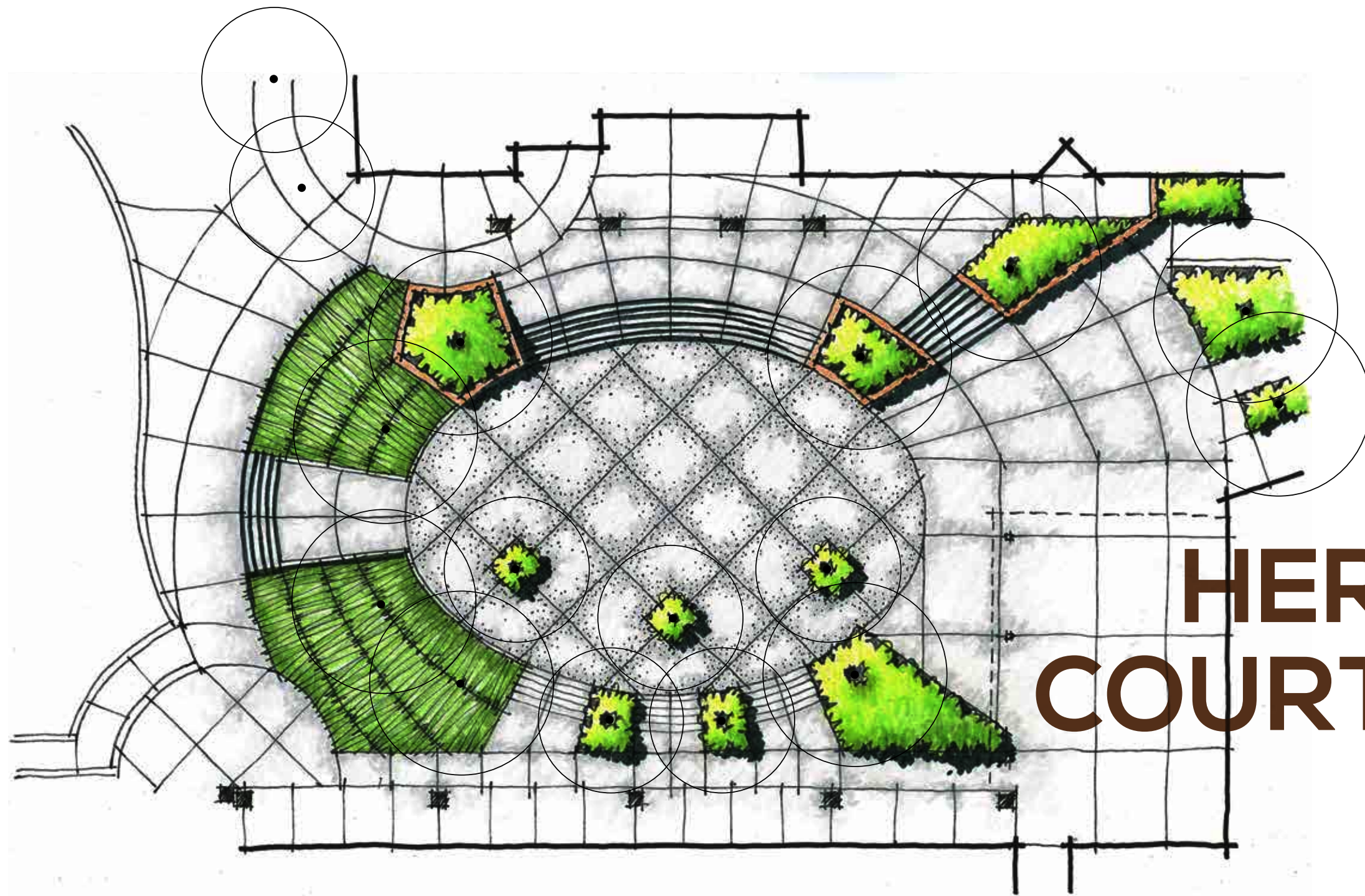
