
gift to us. *He had to be made like His brethren in all things ... Since then the children share in flesh and blood, He Himself likewise also partook of the same, that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is the devil (2:14, 17).*

Moses was God's faithful servant (3:5). Amid a flurry of miracles, he gave Israel God's law, which they broke. *Therefore I was angry with that generation ... I swore in My wrath, "They shall not enter my rest" (3:10-11).* But Jesus Christ is our high priest. Through Him, *we draw near with confidence to the throne of grace that we may receive mercy and may find grace to help in time of need (4:15-16).*

The Old Testament priests were an exclusive club. Their sacrifices covered the sin of God's chosen people. But only for a time. Priests die and animal sacrifices only cover past sin. But Christ is a priest of a different kind—the kind who lives and forgives forever. *He is able to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them (7:25).*

Christ's blood cleanses us from sin (9:14, 28). He is the hope of the faithful, our model to follow, and power to obey (12:1-3). The babe that cried in a manger in Bethlehem is the God who shook the mountain at Sinai (12:18-21). And when God gives a gift, He never takes it back, or in Christ's words, *I will never leave you, nor will I ever forsake you (13:5).*

As you read the book of Hebrews this Christmas season, think of it as unwrapping God's gift. Rejoice in the eternal blessing He brings. Delight in the hope He purchased. But above all, fall in love with the Giver. All giving begins and ends with Him.

Bible Reading Plan and Prayer Guide

(Year ONE) December 2021

In these last days, God has spoken to us in His Son, whom He appointed heir of all things, through whom also He made the world. And He is the radiance of His glory and the exact representation of His nature, and upholds all things by the word of His power. When He had made purification of sins, He sat down at the right hand of the Majesty on high. —Hebrews 1:2-3

God's Best Gift

Jim Elliot's words still ring true: "God gives the best gifts, when we leave the choice to Him." So often, our needs and longings dominate our prayers, and we lose sight of God's sovereign plan and His gifts of eternal value. If ever there's a time to reflect on the excellence of God's gifts, it's Christmas. And His most excellent gift is the Child Christ.

There's an old habit. Devaluing Christ and insisting there must be more to God's gift. This old habit plagued the Hebrew believers of the first century, as it does many today. Fear of being excluded from Jewish worship tempted them to mix law with grace and trust human effort instead of God's provision. But rejecting God's gift means falling from grace and throwing away the only chance for salvation.

An unknown author, some say Paul but no one knows for sure, wrote these Hebrew saints to convince them to cling to Christ alone. The portrait of Christ he gives reveals how great God's greatest gift truly is.

Even angels can't compare to Christ our Savior. Angels are mere servants, doing God's bidding (1:14). But God's Son reigns. *Your throne, O God, is forever and ever, and the righteous scepter is the scepter of His kingdom (1:8).* As awesome as an angel is, Christ's glory is categorically greater.

No human is His equal. Yes, our Lord is human. He was even mortal, able to die. But His humanity is more than packaging. Incarnation is essential to the way God crafted His
