A Few Words About *Family Time Review*:

Every Sunday you or your child will receive our half-sheet **Family Time Review**. We want this to become a *special* tool for you and your kids to review and to spark sweet conversations about what we are working through on Sunday mornings.

Sunday School Bible Lessons for July and the Christ Connection for each story:

July 3 - Ruth and Boaz (Ruth 1 - 4)

Boaz was a family redeemer. That means he would help his close relatives who were in trouble. Boaz cared for Ruth and Naomi because their husbands had died. In a similar way, Jesus is our Redeemer. We need help because we sin. Jesus brought our salvation for us by taking our punishment when He died on the cross.

July 10 - Eli and Samuel (1 Samuel 1 - 3)

Samuel used God's words to tell the people what God is like. John 1:1 says that Jesus is the Word. Jesus showed the world what God is like, and He told people to turn away from their sin. Jesus ultimately freed people from the Power of sin by dying on the cross and rising again.

July 17 Israel Demanded a King (1 Samuel 8 -10)

God intended for a heavenly king to rule over Israel, but the Israelites did not trust God's plan. So God chose Saul to be their king. God had a plan to one day send His Son, Jesus, to rule the entire world. Jesus would be the perfect King who would bring peace and salvation to the world.

July 24 - God Rejected Saul as King (1 Samuel 13:1 -14 and 15:1 - 3)

King Saul sinned by giving a sacrifice that only the priest was allowed to give. God rejected Saul as king, but He had a plan to send His Son, Jesus. King Jesus gave up His own life as a good and perfect sacrifice so sinners would be forgiven and accepted

July 31 - David was Anointed and Fought Goliath (1 Samuel 16 - 17)

David was not a big or strong warrior, but he trusted God. God gave David power. When God sent His Son to earth, Jesus did not look like a strong warrior either. But by dying on the cross and coming back to life, Jesus showed His power to save sinners.
