A Few Words About *Family Time Review*:

Every Sunday you or your child will receive our half-sheet ***Family Time Review***. We want this to become a *special* tool for you and your kids to review and spark sweet conversations about what we are working through on Sunday mornings.

Sunday School Bible lessons for October and the Christ Connection for each story:

November 6 - God Called Isaiah (Isaiah 6) Isaiah saw Holy God in His glory.

Isaiah had a vision for God's glory and realized his own sin. God forgave Isaiah's sin. Like Isaiah, when we see how holy God is, we see how sinful we are. God sent His Son, Jesus, to pay for our sin. We can find salvation only in Him.

November 13 - Isaiah Preached about the Messiah (Isaiah 53) God said the Messiah would be a suffering servant.

God planned all along that Jesus would die on the cross for our sin. Seven hundred years before Jesus was born, the prophet Isaiah wrote that this would happen! Jesus is the Servant who suffered so that those who trust in Him would be forgiven.

November 20 - Hezekiah, Judah's Faithful King (2 Kings 18-20) God answered Hezekiah's prayer.

Hezekiah prayed that God would save His people from their enemies so that everyone would know that He is the one true God. God answered Hezekiah's prayer. Jesus also prayed for His people to be saved. Through His death and resurrection, Jesus brought glory to God by rescuing people from sin and death.

November 24 -Thanksgiving Day

November 27 - Jonah Prophet to Nineveh (Jonah 1-4) God showed mercy to the Ninevites.

God called Jonah to go to his enemies and tell them to stop sinning. Jonah did not want to go. He ran away. Later, God sent His own Son, Jesus to tell His enemies to stop sinning. Unlike Jonah, Jesus wanted to obey God. He died on the cross to save us from sin.
