Sunday School Bible Lessons for April and the Christ Connection for each story:

Every Sunday, you or your child will receive a half-sheet of paper that we call our **Family Time Review**. We want this to become a *special* tool for you and your children to use to review their Bible lessons at home each week. We pray that you will have many good, sweet and deep conversations together.

April 2 - Palm Sunday/ Children's Easter Celebration Day - Jesus' Crucifixion and Resurrection (Matthew 26:36-28:10; John 18:1-20:18)

The crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus is the center of the gospel. We deserve to die because of our sin, but Jesus died in our place. He was the blood sacrifice made once and for all for the forgiveness of sin. God was pleased with Jesus' sacrifice and raised Jesus from the dead to reign as King over all creation. We are forgiven only through Jesus. (Acts 4:12)

April 9 - Easter Sunday/Elementary Family Sunday. This means that all children who are in 1st graders and older, will attend the church service with their parents. All kindergarten and under children **will** have a program during the 9:00 and the 10:15 services this Easter day.

Kindergarten and Under - Jesus' Crucifixion and Resurrection (Matthew 26:36-28:10; John 18:1-20:18)

The crucifixion and resurrection of Jesus is the center of the gospel. We deserve to die because of our sin, but Jesus died in our place. He was the blood sacrifice made once and for all for the forgiveness of sin. God was pleased with Jesus' sacrifice and raised Jesus from the dead to reign as King over all creation. We are forgiven only through Jesus. (Acts 4:12)

April 16 - God Saved His People Through Esther (Esther 5-10)

God was in control over Haman's evil plan to destroy the Jews. Like Haman, Satan wants to destroy believers. Satan thought he had won when Jesus died on the cross, but God raised Jesus from the dead and defeated Satan once and for all.

April 23 - Nehemiah Heard New of Jerusalem (Nehemiah 1-2)

Nehemiah trusted that God would keep His promise to protect his people and give Him them a home. When we trust in Jesus, we believe God will keep his promise to give us - His people - a home. Jesus obeyed God perfectly. He died on the cross and rose again so we can have a home with him forever.

April 30 - Jerusalem's Walls Were Rebuilt - (Nehemiah 3:1-6:16)

Nehemiah led the people to rebuild the wall around Jerusalem to protect them from enemies. Jesus came to protect us from our enemies He died on the cross and rose from the dead to rescue people from sin and death.
