9:10 ~ Children divide into small groups with their teachers and start their rotations of Bible lesson, playground, snack, big group worship, and lesson review. Small group grade signs are posted outside each classroom.

10:15 ~ Parent Check Out ~ Parents check out their elementary children from inside the **Playground**. To check out your children, please put your child's name tag in the Name Tag Basket, gather their belongings, and take a Family Time Review sheet to enjoy at home.



Playground Fellowship & Safety:

Please come to the playground after the church service and enjoy some great fellowship with the teachers as you watch your children play. At 10:30 the teachers leave for second service, so parents are in charge of their child's safety after that time. We recommend children in kindergarten-and-under use only the play equipment on the north side of the playground. Someone will be watching the east playground gates until 10:50, however, and will not allow any child to leave without a parent while they are there.
